

AIMS Website Portal FAQs

(Revised September 23, 2009)

- **If my club does online registration with ITSoccerNet, how can i get the data uploaded into Aims and is there a fee involved?**

Answer: Due to the fact that Online Registration is unavailable in Aims for the Indoor Season, we will allow clubs who use Online Registration with ITSoccerNet to upload into Aims at no cost.

- **Where can i access a Report to see what programs players are registered too if members do online registration?**

There will be an Online Registration Report that will show this information, it is not available as Online Registration is not live

- **Currently, historical team data is hidden under Inactive Status. How do we change and or delete the history and retain only the 2009 outdoor team data for future use?**

Team Roster information from 2009 and prior has been archived By Request we can pull a Roster report for you, in order to complete this request we would need the name of each player, date of birth and their OSA. All Teams will have to be recreated for the first time only in the upcoming indoor season. After that all teams previously created in the Indoor 2009/2010 season will be carried over to each season

- **How do I transfer my domain to the AIMS website?**

You need to contact the company that handles your DNS record and have them create 2 subdomains:

www.soccerclub.com

portal.soccerclub.com

Both of these subdomains need to be pointed to the OSA's IP address:

69.90.75.74

*This is done through the use of an **A-Record**, which is done with the company that is hosting your DNS records. The hostname is the subdomain (ie. portal.soccerclub.com) and the IP address is 69.90.75.74.*

If you are having difficulties creating or modifying your A-Record contact the company previously hosting your DNS records to complete this process and then contact the IT department at the OSA to arrange the redirection on the other end.
